Bringing Our Wayward Brethren Back

“Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such a one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted” (Gal. 6:1). Restoring the erring is one area in which the church is badly failing.

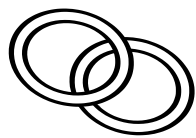
