A specialty-tool approach would be unnecessary. Sometimes just a gentle hand on the shoulder and soft tone of the voice is exactly what the person needs to get through a rough spot and/or make the changes necessary in his life. Heartfelt compassion can go a long way in most instances!

Every situation and every person is unique! We ought to thank God for that!



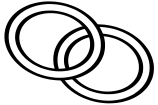

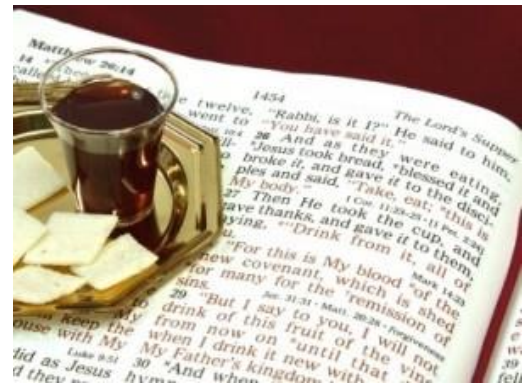
