God is So Good to Me!

The special providence of God is one of the richest blessings that children of God can enjoy. In the Old Testament, Joseph was thrown into a pit, sold into slavery, and ended up in an Egyptian prison. Many would ask, “Where’s God? Why has God allowed all of this to happen?”

About 40 years after his brothers started him down this path of misfortune, Joseph looked back and saw the Lord at work for the “good” of His people. January 14: Potluck and congregational meeting after morning services. Men will then meet at 4:30 the same day to discuss the agenda and congregational feedback.

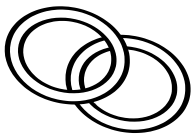
January 25: Ladies Class at the home of Linda Wooldridge at 6:30 p.m. We will begin Chapter 5.
