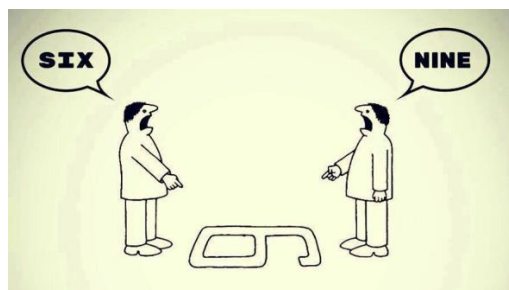
2017 Theme:

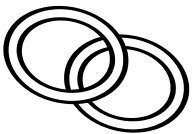
